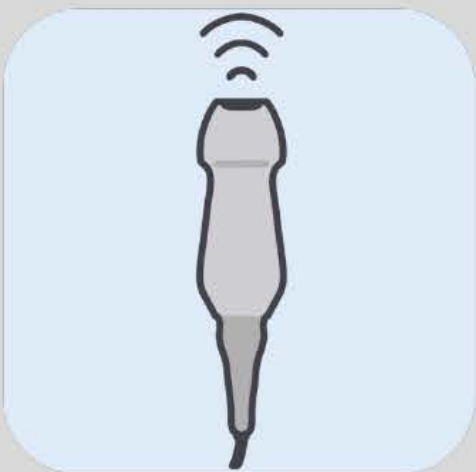

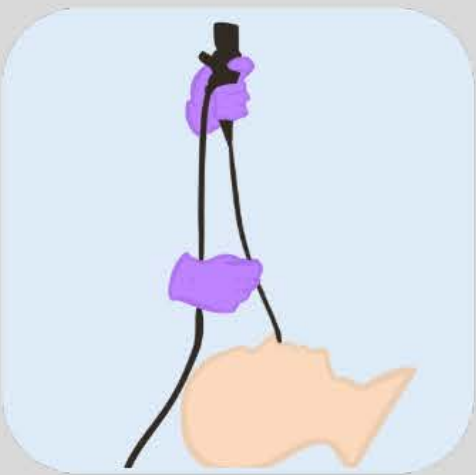

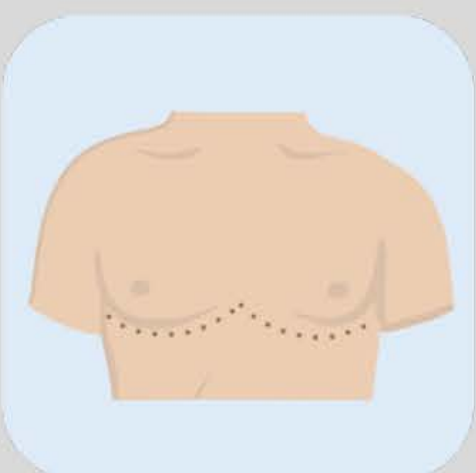
POCUS Echo

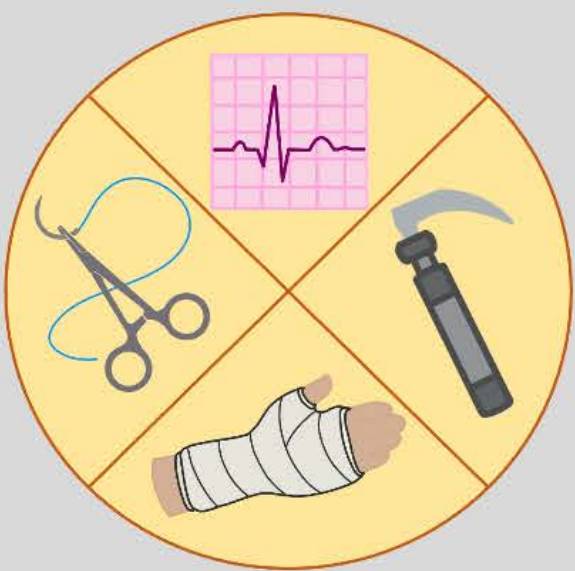


Emergency Skills Cadaver Lab

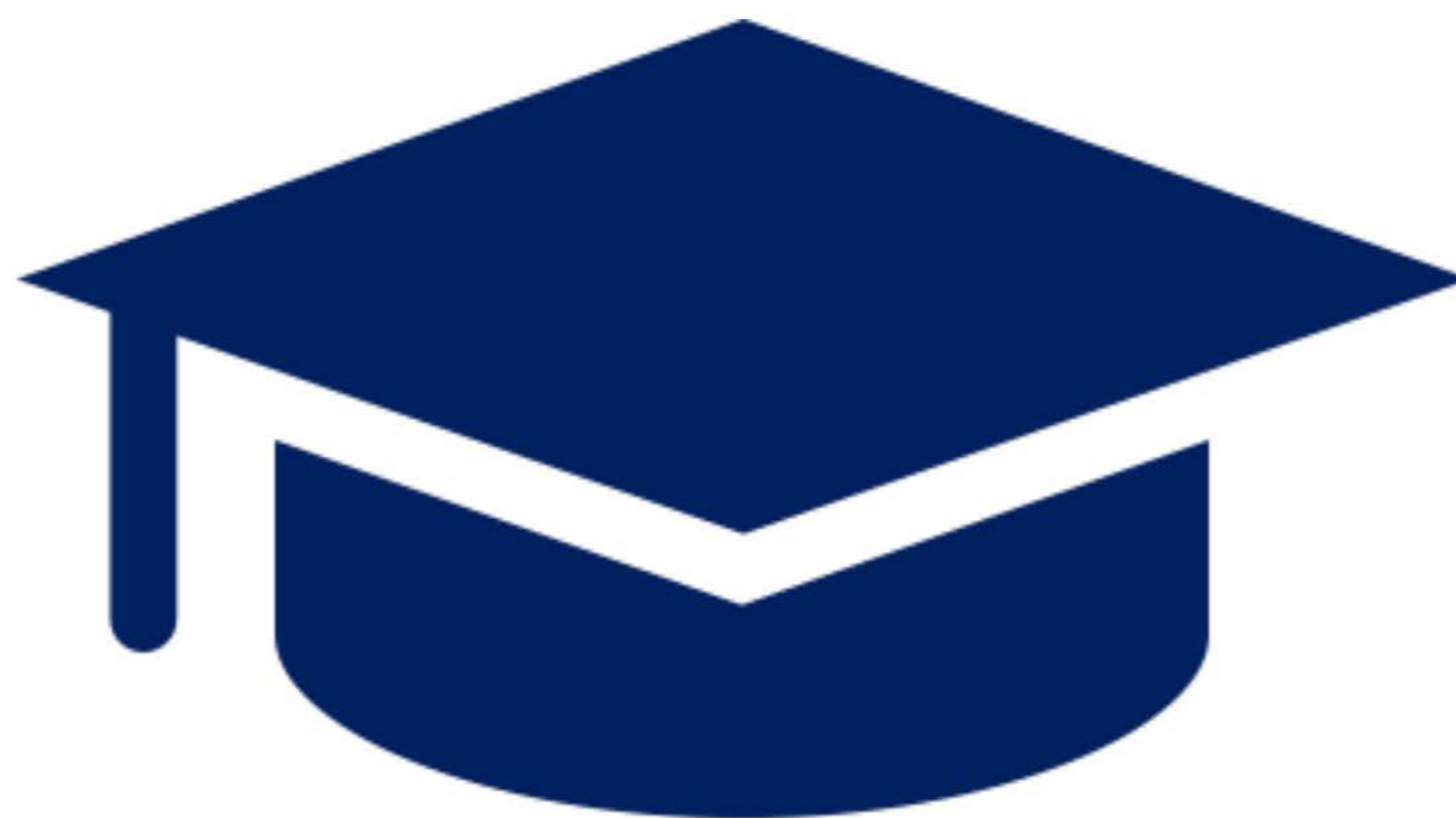

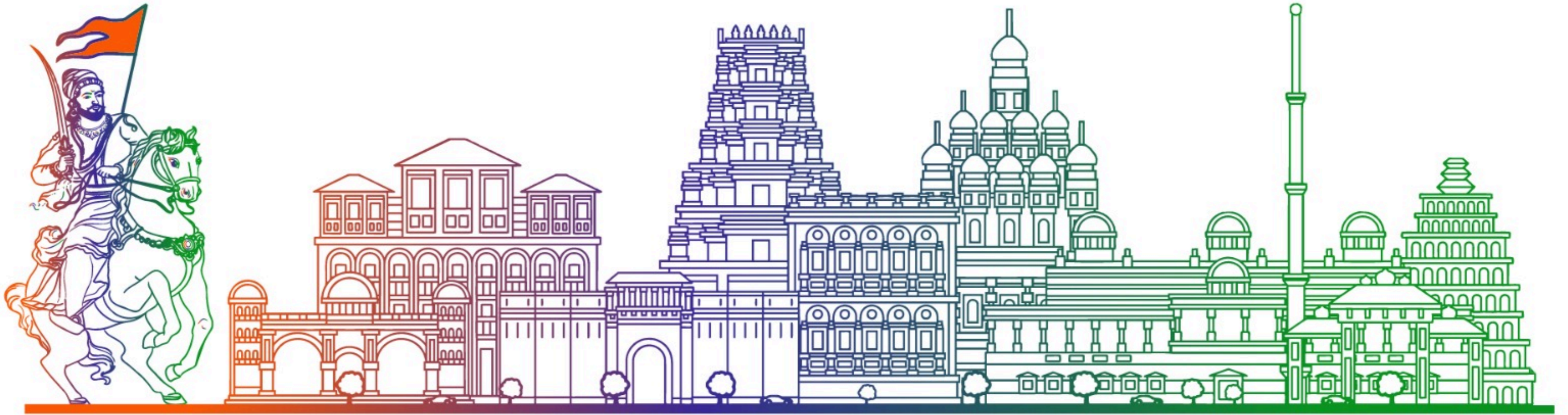
